TOUR PROGRAM

On Monday depart for Warsaw, Poland

DAY 1/Tue - ARRIVE WARSAW. Upon arrival in Warsaw, the capital of Poland, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. There is plenty of time to relax before meeting your fellow travelers and tour director. (D)

Day 2/Wed - WARSAW. This 700 year old capital of Poland is a symbol of nationhood and the will to survive against great odds. A sightseeing tour here includes a drive along the famous Royal Route from magnificent Castle Square to Lazienki Park and Palace, summer residence of the last king of Poland. Pass by the Palace of Science and Culture (known as a "wedding cake"), the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Monument to the Heroes of the Warsaw Ghetto and the Barbican. Continue with the walking tour of the Old Town, colorful Market Square and St. John's Cathedral. The rest of the day is free for relaxing, shopping or an optional late afternoon Chopin concert. (B)

Day 3/Thu - WARSAW-KRAKOW. This morning, journey to Czestochowa, known for the blackened picture of St. Mary in the Jasna Gora Monastery, popularly called the "Black Madonna". In the afternoon, there is time for an optional side trip to one of the most somber memorials of the past, Auschwitz. End your day in Krakow. (B, D)

Day 4/Fri - KRAKOW. Your sightseeing tour starts with a visit to the Wawel Hill, viewing the Royal Castle and visiting the Royal Cathedral. Enjoy a walking tour of the Old Town where you will visit the Main Market Square, Renaissance Cloth Hall and St. Mary's Church. The afternoon is free

for a stroll around the city. (B)

Day 5/Sat - KRAKOW-PRAGUE. After a drive through the Polish countryside, cross the borders of Slovakia and Czech Republic. Then, on to Prague, with its Baroque churches, promenades, parks and ancient city walls. (B, D)

Day 6/Sun - PRAGUE. Built on the seven hills more than 1000 years ago and situated on both banks of the Vltava River, Prague is one of the most attractive cities in Europe. Your city tour starts with a panoramic drive to the famous Wenceslas Square, the Strahov Stadium and the Castle Square. On a walking tour, visit the Royal Castle of Hradcany, St. Vitus Cathedral, Royal Palace and Loretto Church. Cross the Charles Bridge and walk through the old quarter of Prague to view the Jewish Ghetto, Town Hall and the world famous Astronomical Clock. The balance of the day is free. An optional visit to a cultural performance will be available. (B)

Day 7/Mon - PRAGUE-VIENNA. Today's destination is Vienna, the "City of Waltz", and one of Europe's loveliest cities. (B)

Day 8/Tue - VIENNA. On your morning sightseeing tour, visit the Hofburg Palace, once the seat of the Austro-Hungarian Empire, and view the Belvedere Palace, Prater amusement park, the UN buildings, St. Stephen's Cathedral and other vivid reminders of the city's imperial history. Afternoon is at leisure to enjoy last day in Vienna on your own. Farwell dinner in a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 9/Wed - DEPART VIENNA. Transfer to the airport for your departure flight. (B)

Travel Tips . . .



TIME: Six hours ahead of US Eastern Daylight Time. The 24-hour clock is used.

ELECTRICITY: 220V/50 cycles. All purpose converter and 2-prong adapter are required for US appliances.

WARDROBE: Dress comfortably. Casual clothes of wrinkle-free fabrics are suggested for daily wear. Valuable jewelry should be left at home. Take a warm sweater or jacket, an umbrella or a raincoat with a hood. Comfortable walking shoes are a must. Laundry service is available in hotels.

INOCULATIONS: Not required by law.

WEATHER: Temperatures in Europe are similar to those of New England.

CREDIT CARDS: Most hotels, major restaurants and shops (except street vendors), accept major credits cards including Master card, Visa and rarely American Express. No Discover Card.

To exchange money you can use Exchange places or ATM machines available in major cities in tourist areas.
